

ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 01

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2014-01  
OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN REGULATING THE SALE, POSSESSION, AND  
CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IN THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN,  
MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2014 the Village of Franklin adopted Ordinance No. 2014-01, regulating the sale, possession, and consumption of alcoholic liquor in the Village of Franklin, Morgan County, Illinois;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN, ILLINOIS:

**Section 1:** Section 2-6 shall be amended to read as follows:

2-6 CLASSES OF LICENSES; NUMBER; TERM; ANNUAL FEES. Licenses required by this Ordinance shall be of 3 classes, designated L-1, L-2, and L-3.

1. L-1. An L-1 license shall enable the licensee to sell, at retail, on the premises licensed, any alcoholic liquor, wine or beer in the original package only and for consumption off the licensed premises only, which premises shall not have sales of alcoholic liquor, beer and wine comprising more than 25% of its annual sales. The annual license fee for an L-1 license shall be \$1,000.
2. L-2. An L-2 license shall enable the licensee to sell, at retail, on the premises licensed, any alcoholic liquor, wine or beer, for consumption on the licensed premises only, which premises shall not have sales of alcoholic liquor, beer and wine comprising more than 50% of its annual sales. The annual license fee for an L-2 license shall be \$1,200.
3. L-3. An L-3 license shall allow the licensee to sell, at retail, on the premises licensed, any alcoholic liquor, wine or beer, for consumption on or off the licensed premises, which premises shall not have sales of alcoholic liquor, beer and wine comprising more than 50% of its annual sales. The annual license fee for an L-3 license shall be \$1,300.
4. Outdoor Sales. It shall be unlawful for any licensee to sell, give or deliver any alcoholic liquor in any place other than the licensed premises described in his application for the license. Provided, however, the holder of an L-2 or L-3 license may be issued a permit to sell such alcoholic liquor as his license permits, and at such time as it permits, outside the permanent structure; provided that such outdoor area is completely enclosed by a fence or wall at least five (5) feet high; and provided that access to such outdoor area is restricted to one (1) door, gate or other opening no more than five (5) feet wide; and provided that such outdoor area is not more than

sixty (60) feet from the permanent structure which contains the licensed premises. No alcoholic liquor shall be sold, given or delivered by any person who is in such outdoor area to any person who is not in such area. Such outdoor area shall be deemed a part of the licensed premises for all purposes specified in this article.

No more than 2 licenses under this Ordinance shall be in effect at any time.

**Section 2:** Section 3-1 shall be amended to read as follows:

3-1 HOURS. An L-1 license shall permit the sale of alcoholic liquor, beer, or wine from 6:30 a.m. each Monday - Saturday until 10:01 p.m. the same day, and from 12:00 noon each Sunday until 10:01 p.m. that same day.

L-2 and L-3 licenses shall permit sales from 6:00 a.m. each Sunday - Thursday until 1:30 a.m. the following day, and from 6:00 a.m. each Friday and Saturday until 2:00 a.m. the following day.

**Section 3:** All ordinances, parts of ordinances and amendments to ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this Ordinance are repealed as of the effective date hereof. All Ordinances, parts of Ordinances and Amendments to Ordinances not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


**Section 4:** The Village Clerk is hereby instructed to publish this Ordinance in Pamphlet Form.

**Section 5:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
