Special Meeting Minutes  
March 6, 2024

Mayor Paul Turpin called the special meeting of the Village of Franklin Board of Trustees to order at 6:01 pm on Wednesday, March 6, 2024 in the town hall. Trustees present were Abby Flynn, Wyatt Smith, Lauren Whalen, Sarah Carter, and Vickie Adkins. Trustee Amanda Ahlers was absent.

Mayor Turpin reviewed the Right of Way Ordinance with the Board of Trustees, reading through the description and main bullet points. He informed the Board that he sent out the questions and concerns from the original copy. Some of the concerns were justifiable and added, but others were not. The ordinance primarily tells them where they can and cannot go. It covers ditches, alleyways, and streets. It covers utility companies with the Village and residents. They will have to pothole and reseed under the Village's discretion. One of the Village's utility employees must be always with them and they will have to apply for a permit. The permit costs \$1,500.00. Lauren Whalen made a motion to accept an Ordinance Establishing Standards for the Construction of Utility Facilities within the Public Ways of the Village of Franklin, Illinois. Abby Flynn seconded the motion. The voting was as follows: Wyatt Smith-yes, Lauren Whalen-yes, Sarah Carter-yes, Vickie Adkins-yes, and Abby Flynn-yes. The motion was carried.
